



The eye care cost is very expensive so everyone haven't access. The Sun of Hope ministries working on holistic development of the communities has signed a partnership agreement with an eye hospital of Benin in order to organize periodic eye care campaigns. This new strategy to preach the Gospel was attended by over 250 people at its first edition. The consultation session comes in 3 steps represented by 3 stop stations. At the first station, the patient is received by an ophthalmologist who consults him and gives him the diagnosis about his eyes. At the second station, the patient is received by pastors who present him the Gospel and pray for him.

At this station they are also the pastors of the close churches who are ready to welcome new believers and guide them to the nearest church and at the third station, the patient is received again by another doctors who gives him medication and eyeglasses. Some patients with severe cases are redirected to the hospital for surgery.

This method allowed to record the conversion of more than 40 people in one session. This new strategy is one of the strategies that Sun of Hope thinks to promote in the coming years. The only problem with this strategy is that it needs a lot of resources to mobilize, a team of doctors and vehicles to go to the villages to meet the lost souls.
